RESOLUTION NO. 2024 - 10

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF HONEY BROOK TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE CONTRACT(S) AWARD FOR THE PURCHASE OF DIESEL FUEL THROUGH BERKS COUNTY JOINT PURCHASING FOR THE AWARD PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2024 TO JUNE 30, 2025.

WHEREAS, Honey Brook Township is a Second Class Township in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, as a Second Class Township, Honey Brook Township is governed by the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 1502 of the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. § 66502, provides for purchases deemed to be in the best interest of the Township by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, purchases through the Berks County Joint Purchasing Board satisfies the requirements for bids for purchases of materials and supplies provided for in the Second Class Township Code; and

WHEREAS, the Township has identified the need to purchase diesel fuel for the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, World Fuel Services can provide diesel fuel under a Berks County Joint Purchasing Board Contract; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Honey Brook Township that the Township Manager and the Director of Public Works are authorized to purchase diesel fuel from World Fuel Services according to the attached tally sheets of awarded vendors and prices under a Berks County Joint Purchasing Board Contract; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any provision, sentence, clause, section, or part of this Resolution shall for any reason be found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such determination shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Resolution, and it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Honey Brook that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision, sentence, clause, section or part not been included herein.

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

FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby superseded.


FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective for the award period of July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025.
